

Shinji Sabage PARK DANDAN Terms of Use

Equipment regulation

Available BB bullets

- Bio-bullets of 0.25g or less and luminescent **bio-bullets** can be used. (0.28g is possible only for air cocking) * The weight of the bullet may be measured without notice regardless of whether it is during the game or during a break.

Power of airsoft gun

- The power of the airsoft gun you bring in will be checked by the management staff with a bullet speed measuring instrument. We will measure whether it is new, unmodified, used, or measured elsewhere (handguns can only be modified or used with an external source).

- **0.20g → Initial velocity less than 98m / s**
- **0.25g → Initial velocity less than 87m / s**
- **0.28g → Initial velocity less than 83m / s**

Only airsoft guns can be used.

- The fully automatic cycle of the electric gun can be used at less than 30 shots / sec.
- Use of deceleration adapter is prohibited.
- Adjustment of the gun after measuring the bullet speed is prohibited. If it is discovered, we will deal with it according to the situation.
- If you need to disassemble and adjust, please contact the staff.

Gas / CO2 gas gun

- [HFC-134a] [HFC-152a] Only co2 cartridges and green gas sold in **Japan can be used**.
- The external source gas gun can only be used with the Sun Pro regulator. Only items within the initial velocity regulation can be used with the valve fully open.
- The use and refilling of gas cans with replaced contents, foreign-made gas, mixed gas, gas with a higher pressure than the above gas, etc. are **regulated by law**. If use is discovered, we will take appropriate measures.

About other equipment

- Do not use airsoft guns with a sharp muzzle or airsoft guns with an inner barrel.
- Tactical light can be used with 1000 lumens or less.
- Use of lasers is prohibited. (Can be installed if the laser is not lit)
- Use of spiked shoes and crampons is prohibited.

- Please refrain from adjusting the rental gun by yourself. Please hand over the malfunction and adjustment of the rental gun to the management.

Regulations in the safety area

- Never point the muzzle at anyone except during the game.
- Put the selector in safety outside the game area. (Even if you can't enter the safety without cocking, please put the selector in the safety)
- Do not put your finger on the trigger.
- Do not install the magazine.
- Do not shoot in the air.
- Grenade bullet replenishment and gas replenishment are prohibited. (Please go at the designated place in the field)

When leaving the game at the end of the game or a hit

1. Put the selector in safety

2. Remove the magazine

3. Shoot 3 or more shots into the bullet removal box when leaving.

Be sure to do the above and make sure there are **no bullets inside the gun** before entering the safety area. The bullet removal box is installed at the entrance gate and the catwalk stairs.

Regulations in the game area

Precautions for game rules

- Whole body hit system. If you hit a BB bullet even once, including airsoft guns and equipment, it will be a hit.
- When the hit person hits the BB bullet, he / she **self-reports by saying "hit!"** And raising his / her hand so that the surroundings can understand it.
- Friendly fire is treated as a hit only on the shot side.
- A bullet that bounces off an artificial object such as a control panel in the CQB area or a street light is a no-hit. A bullet that hits a tree trunk, branch, leaf, or bush with a different trajectory is treated as a hit. (No hit on the ground)
- Be sure to check the full-auto and semi-auto restrictions for electric guns depending on

the area. (The map displayed is available)

- Freeze call is established only when the other party says "hit" and raises his hand.
- Dash and slide within the range where there is no danger (the risk of hitting a barricade or other customers increases, the hit judgment becomes ambiguous, etc.). If the staff judges that it is dangerous, we may limit it.

Banned acts in the game

- A **zombie act** without a hit call and action even if it hits.
- Overkill that keeps shooting even though the opponent is hit.
- The act of using a hit person as a shield.
- A blind fire that shoots with only a gun out of the control panel or behind a tree without aiming.
- Outright respawn kill.
- Do not follow the rules of resurrection.
- Abuse, swearing, strange voices, and defamation of the other party that disturb the atmosphere of the place.
- Contact with the opponent's body or gun.
- The act of scattering, shooting in the direction above the height of the obstacle.
- Shooting above the safety net.
- Goggles and shooting glasses for purposes other than Sabage such as sunglasses and glasses cannot be used (even in the shooting range). Mesh goggles can be used but are not recommended. We recommend using a face guard.
- Please report violations of rules and prohibited acts to the staff without communicating with each other. The staff will support you.

New coronavirus countermeasures

- During the spread of the new coronavirus, please wear a mask when talking in the hall. In particular, please refrain from talking during meals.
- If your body temperature is 37.5 ° C or higher at the time of reception, please return and take measures according to the local government.
- We have a disinfectant solution in the restroom and hall, so please cooperate in disinfecting.
- If you feel unwell, such as feverishness, coughing, or dullness, please do not overdo it even after passing the temperature measurement.
- Please refrain from participating if you **have traveled outside Japan within 7 days**, not including the day you participated in the game.

Precautions when using the facility

- You can participate in the game by diving, but we recommend you to make a reservation. If you make a reservation on the dedicated site, you will be able to contact us individually, such as canceling the event due to bad weather, canceling the event due to other disasters or unavoidable circumstances, and paying attention to the parking lot and participation on the day. You can make a reservation by phone, but if you are new to us, we will ask you for your email address.

- If you use the game area or shooting area on business days, please be sure to pay the fee at the reception. Even if you leave the venue after payment, we will not refund the fee.

- Even if the price is rounded up earlier than normal business hours due to sudden bad weather, the fee will not be refunded. If sudden bad weather is predicted just before the game is held, participants will be asked to confirm their intention to participate before the game is held.

- Please check the field charter rules separately in the homepage charter rules.

- Please take your garbage home with you. (Garbage bags are available at the reception for free)

- Please carry the airsoft gun in a gun case or gun bag from the parking lot to the safety area. Please wear a jacket other than camouflage uniform before moving.

- Vehicles cannot enter the premises other than those involved in the operation and the charter organizer.

- Please bring a portable ashtray and smoke behind the reception hall. Please refrain from smoking on the road to the parking lot and safety area.

- A cassette stove can be used in the safety area during normal holding. Bonfires are prohibited (events such as endurance battles are operated according to different rules).

- Please let us know immediately if any troubles such as accidents, injuries or thefts occur in the facility or during the game. Please note that you are basically responsible for any injuries during the game due to the nature of sports.

- We are not responsible for any vehicle contact accidents or troubles in the parking lot.

- If you do not follow the staff's cautions and requests, we will take care of you individually. If you do not see any improvement despite your caution, you will be asked to leave the venue and you will be prohibited from using this field for one year from that date.

- Children can participate from the 4th grade of elementary school or 10 years old or older. For details, please read "About the age limit for participation" on the homepage.

- For those who cannot communicate in a language and cannot communicate with each other, up to 3 people can participate in the game per interpreter. You do not need to be accompanied during the game, but please note that you must stay in the safety area.

Prohibited acts in the facility

- Use of the field on non-business days. After discovery or analysis with a surveillance camera, we may report to the police.
- Unauthorized sales and business activities.
- Do not bring in combustibles such as alcoholic beverages, sprays, fireworks, and smoke screens.
- Bringing cutlery into the facility. * Bayonets and imitations are prohibited regardless of the material such as rubber.
- Please do not bring in any other items that the staff deems dangerous.
- Drinking inside and outside the facility, admission with alcohol.
- We will refuse any entry of gangsters, gangster-related companies, general assembly shops, or similar persons, or their members (collectively referred to as antisocial forces).

Handling of personal information

- Information on cancellation of the event due to bad weather, notification of events, sudden notifications when using the facility, acquisition of commercial statistical data, acquisition and management of personal information in order to respond to requests from local governments for infectious disease countermeasures increase.
- If you are participating in Sabage in this field for the first time, please fill in your name, address (to the city, ward, town and village) and contact information (phone number or email address) at the reception. For those who make a reservation on the dedicated reservation site or by phone, the entry items will be shortened, such as entering only the phonetic guide and address of your name.
- Please note that we will not be able to answer any inquiries regarding the information of other participants, such as local interviews, telephone or email inquiries.
